

English

Spoken Language: We will encourage your child to speak articulately and in full sentences. There will be plenty of opportunities in the curriculum for the children to talk and become confident speakers to different audiences.

Reading: Your child will be heard to read at least 3x a week. Depending on their reading age this could happen through an individual reading book, a guided reading session or a shared class read.

How can you help? Reading with your child for 5—10 minutes everyday will make a difference. Send in planner EVERY DAY.

Spelling:

These will be sent home weekly in the planners and the children will be tested the following week.

Handwriting: We have high expectations with how our children present their learning. Please encourage your child to practise their handwriting. Attached is a copy of our handwriting formation.

Writing: The focus will be:

Adventure stories, reports and non-fiction texts.

At the end of Year One there will be a Phonics Screening Check—more information will be provided in due course.

Maths

Maths is divided into 6 main areas which we teach throughout the term. These are: number, place value, the 4 operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division), fractions, measurement, geometry.

PE: Throwing and catching, Relationships with others, and opinions, Cool core (strength


RE: Remembering Roots; Being Hopeful and Visionary; Being Curious and Valuing Knowledge; Being Open, Honest and Truthful
