## <u>Art</u>

At Paganel, through the school's delivery of a broad and balanced curriculum the artistic knowledge and skills outlined in the National Curriculum (2014) are taught discretely to our children within the context of a range of exciting and engaging topics which aim to provide opportunities to for children to embody some of the highest forms of human creativity.

It is hoped that the art curriculum at Paganel will inspire and motivate our children to actively participate in this subject area and they will leave the school with the knowledge and skills to continue to advance their creativity in the next stage of their education.
