At Paganel through the school's delivery of a broad and balanced curriculum the music knowledge and skills outlined in the National Curriculum (2014) are taught discretely to our children within the context of a range of exciting and engaging topics which aim to inspire our children to develop a love of music and talent as musicians. In addition to the subject coverage delivered in the context of topics in every year group, the school also provides peripatetic music lessons in Year 4 (Ukulele), Year 5 and Year 6 (Guitar).

Within the Music curriculum the children are given opportunities to perform, listen to, review and evaluate music across a range of historical periods, genres, styles and traditions. Paganel provides opportunities for children to learn to sing and use their voices, create and compose music on their own and with others and to use a variety of musical instruments. The music lessons at Paganel also aim to develop children's understanding of key vocabulary in this area of the curriculum to ensure they can understand and explore how music is created.

It is hoped that the music curriculum at Paganel will inspire and motivate our children to actively participate in this subject area and they will leave the school with the knowledge and understanding to engage critically with music and have the confidence to compose and perform to wider audiences.
