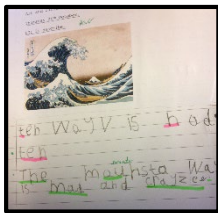


## Art and Culture Week

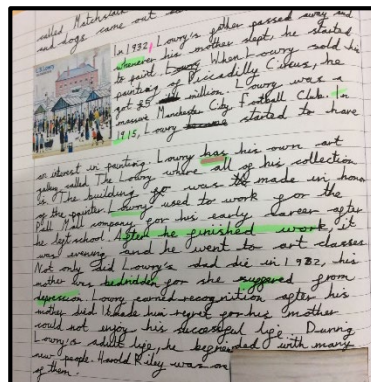
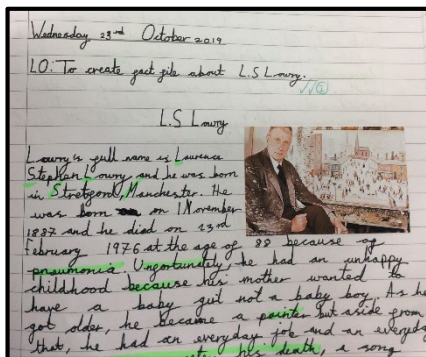
