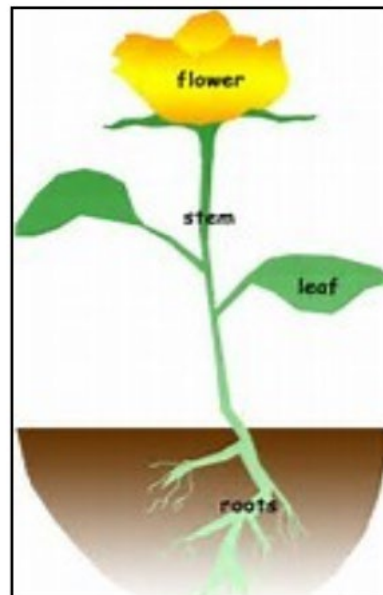
Spelling	Definition/Sentence
leaf	flattened structure of a plant, green and blade-like, that is attached to a stem.
flower	the seed-bearing part of a plant that are typically surrounded by brightly coloured petals
petal	each of the segments of a flower which are usually colourful
bud	a growth on a plant that develops into a leaf, flower, or shoot.
root	the part of a plant which attaches it to the ground.
branch	a part of a tree which grows out from the trunk or from a bough.
stem	the main body or stalk of a plant or shrub

Take it further at home...

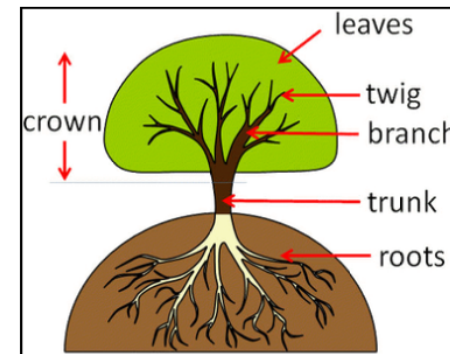
- Grow your own plant or flower and record the changes

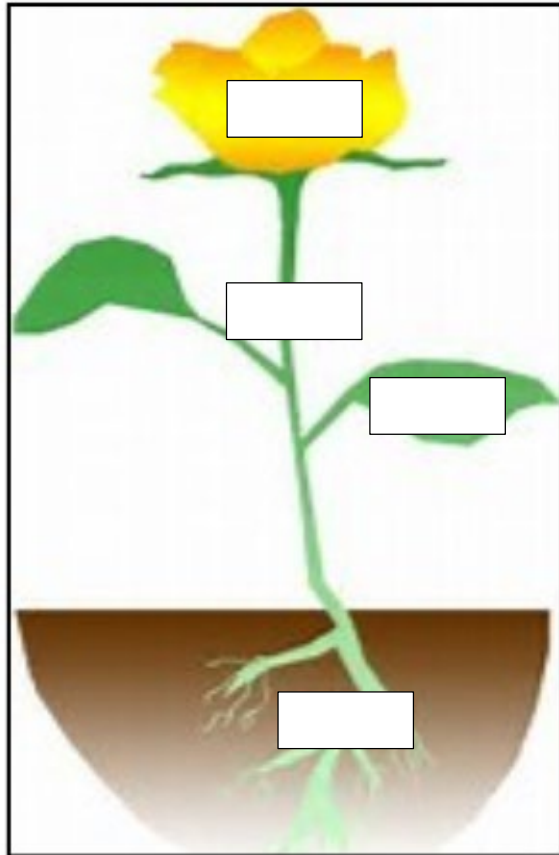
The Structure of a Plant
