Made a Difference




This exciting topic will begin with an art gallery exhibition where children will be introduced to significant people, past and present. These people have made a difference to the world. The children will get the chance to ask questions about the people they see and will be able to provide examples of significant people they know about.

The children's learning journey will then progress to the subject of History, in this subject area the children will be learning about different people who have had an impact and made a difference in the world. The children will find out what they did to make a difference, the consequences some of them faced in the process of trying to make a difference and the impact it has on the world we live in today. They will have the opportunity to complete independent research in addition to the information they are given.



After finding out all about the different significant people, children will be given the opportunity to carry out some Geography work where they will locate the countries they are from on a map and complete independent research to find out information about the countries they originate from.

Following on from Geography, children will look at two different artists that have made an impact on the world and will then create their own art work inspired by one of the artists.



In the second half of the Autumn term children will seek inspiration from the local landmark, Cadbury World, in order to inspire us to design and create our own chocolate bars. As part of Design and Technology, children will design a chocolate bar, design wrappers and carry out market research. The learning journey will conclude with children creating their delicious chocolate bar.



Finally, children will write speeches and make posters about how they were going to become significant individuals in the future. Families will be invited in to hear all about it!
