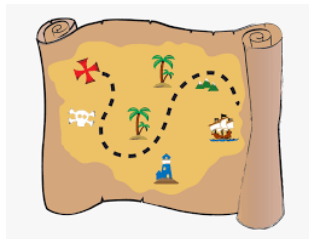
Year Group: Year 1 **Topic:** Treasure Island
