**Topic: Different places, similar lives**

**Prior knowledge**

Some children may have been to another countries or lived in another country so will be able to make comparisons between those places to England. Some children may also have family or friends who live in other countries who they have contact with.

Children will have been exposed to the internet and television and will have some knowledge of other countries.

**Key Knowledge**

- **Qatar** is one of the richest countries in the world. Over 3 million people live there. **Birmingham** has a smaller population of 1.1 million people.
- **When comparing two places, think:** What is different about the physical geography (the trees, fields, rivers)? What is man-made? Which area looks more **populated**? Which area offers more jobs?
- From a young age, children were expected to help out at home with tasks suited to their age and development. They could care for animals and siblings, fetch and carry, cook, and even help out in the family business.
- The \$12 billion Sharq crossing project will comprise three bridges interconnected by subsea tunnels. Designed by Spain's Santiago Calatrava, the crossing includes three bridges spanning between 600 metres and 1,310 metres.  
The delegate from Poland, Ludwik Rajchman, proposed that the UNRRA's remaining funds be allocated to the United Nations International Children's Emergency Fund (UNICEF). It is due to this fundamental action that Ludwik Rajchman is now considered to be the founder of UNICEF.
