Prior knowledge

Children may have experience of being on different forms or transport to travel such as a bus, train or aeroplane. They may have also used some of these different types of transport to travel to different countries.

Children will have been exposed to the internet and television and will have some knowledge of other countries.

Key Knowledge

- **In 1690** the development of the **steam engine** by Denis Papin began, from then it became possible to develop a carriage that could power itself.
- American brothers Orville and Wilbur Wright designed and built the first plane – the 'Wright Flyer' – working on the principle that a lighter engine, twin propellers, and tilted wings would help push the vehicle forward to ensure that it remained airborne.
- The **Gondola** is a flat-bottomed Venetian rowing boat and was a major means of transportation and the most common watercraft within **Venice**.
- Transport can be sorted into three different categories Air, Land and Sea.
- When comparing two types of transport, think: Where does it originate from? How does it move? How fast can it travel? What does it look like?
- Oscar-Claude Monet (1840-1926) is a famous French painter and one of the founders of the Impressionism movement.


